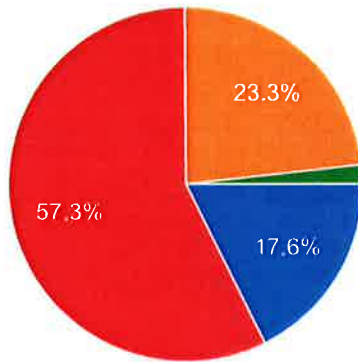

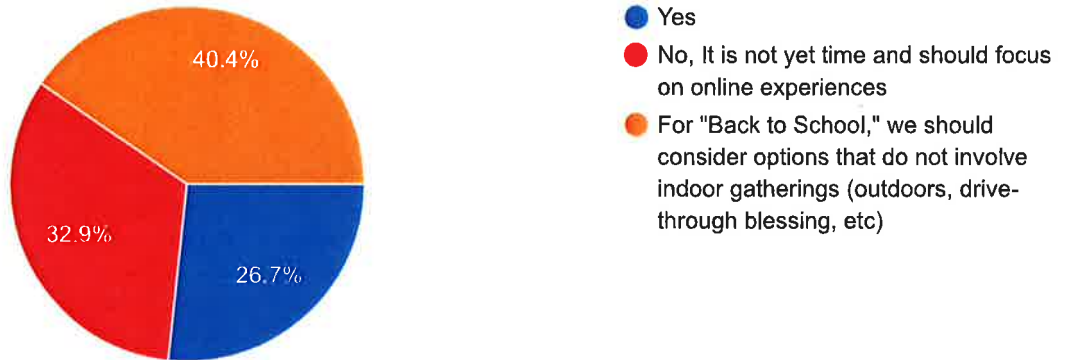

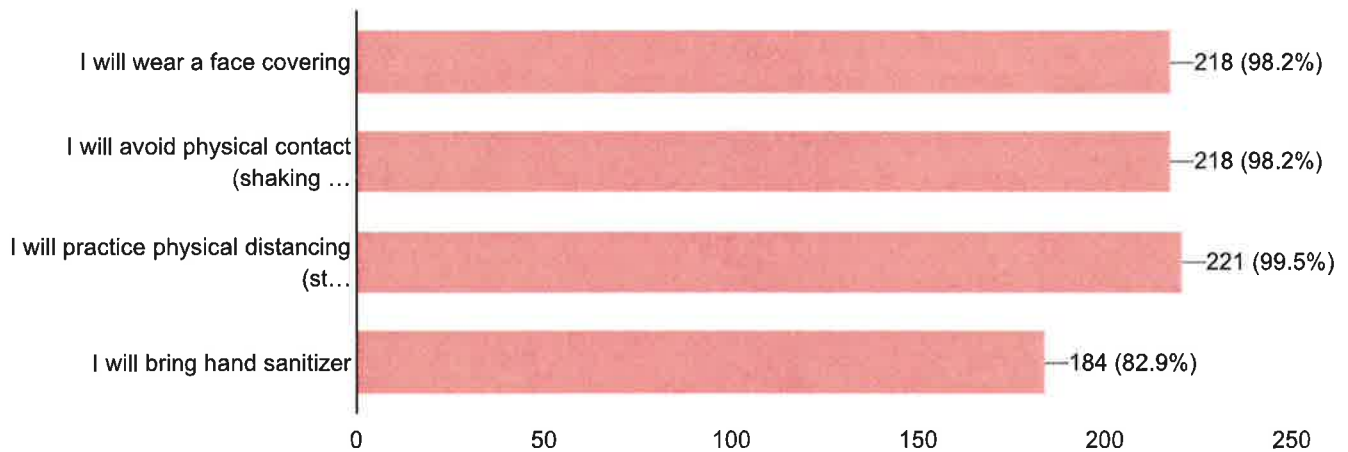

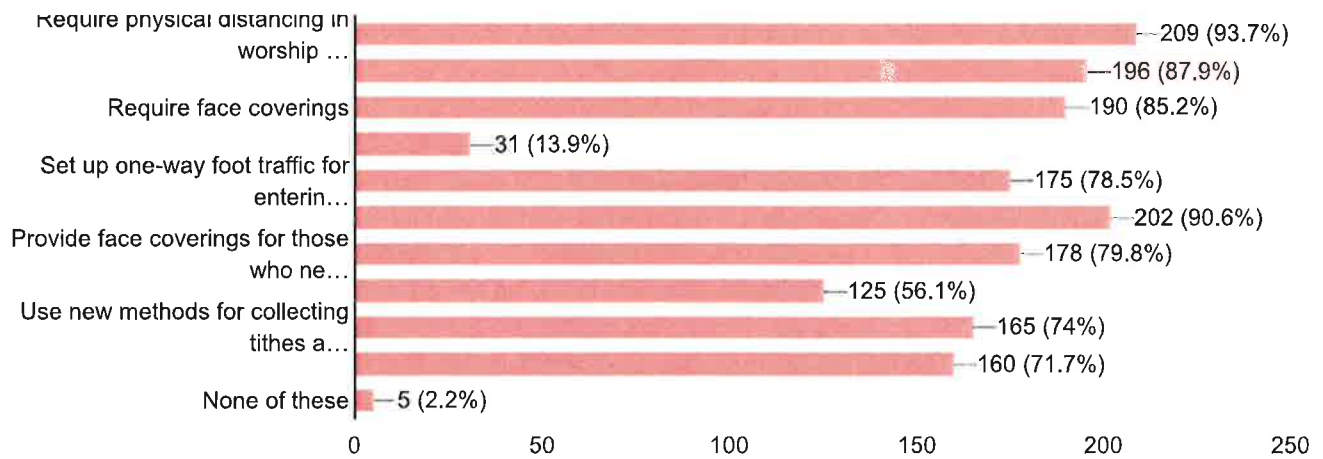
In Stage 2 (see information above) what precautions would you take? Select all that apply.

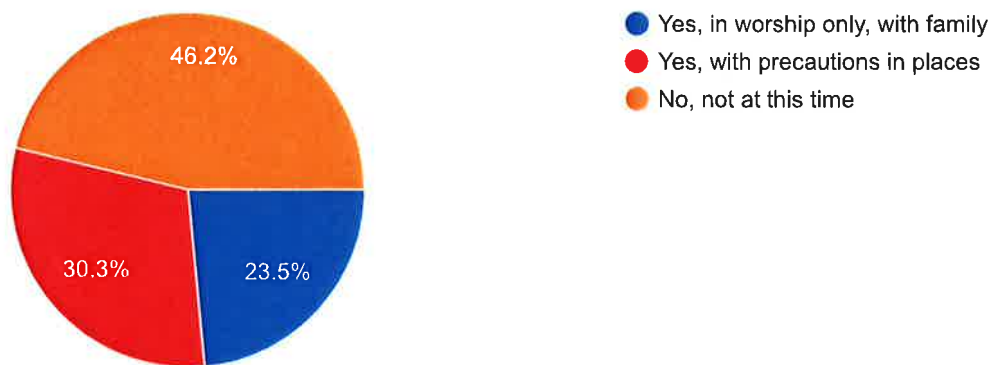
What precautions would you expect the church to take for worship and discipleship gatherings? Select all that apply

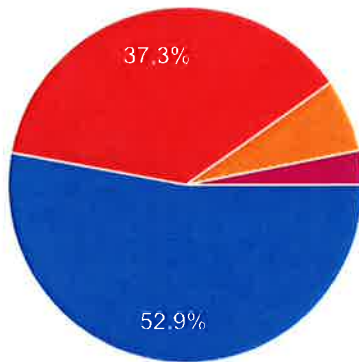

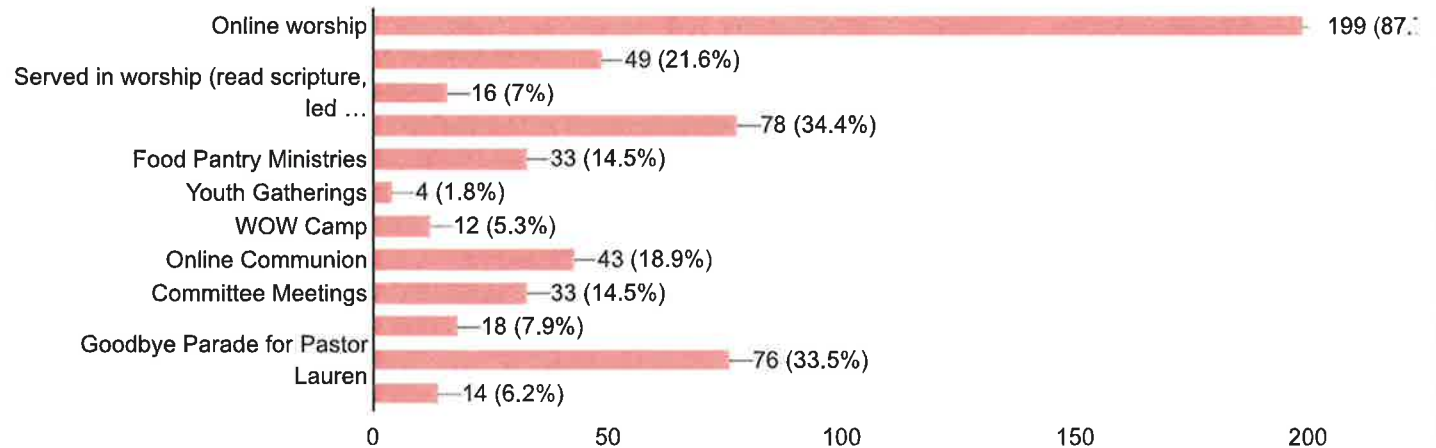

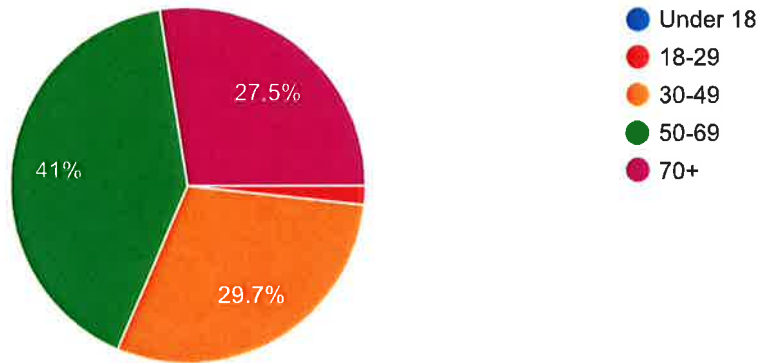
How have you participated in our community since we went primarily online? Select all that apply
