In-Person Worship - The Latest Update

From Dr. Michael Roberts, Senior Pastor:

FUMC Family,

Here is an update on in-person worship, with the major change being the number of services and the schedule. Some rationale and expressions of our hopes are below.

On Oct 18th, we will start with two in-person services, instead of three. Our worship schedule will be the Good News Celebration (GNC) at 9 a.m. in the Great Hall, Online Worship will continue at 9:30 a.m., and our Sanctuary Service will start at 11:15

This change will help us with demands on time as we seek to provide inspiring worship in three different configurations, with a limited pool of volunteers. Please know that the long-term plan is to go back to three in-person services on Sunday morning, and to make these available online, as we continue to develop an active online campus of our church.



We believe this schedule will accommodate those who want to continue with online worship as well as those who want to attend in-person. It will also allow for persons to attend online Sunday School at home and worship

in-person, and for persons or groups to meet at the church during the 10 o'clock hour if so desired.

With the start of school, as well as advances in treatments, evidence showing the effectiveness of face coverings and physical distancing, and from a deep spiritual need, many are expressing a desire to return to in-person worship. Our goal is to honor this and to do so by creating a safe environment. To do this, these services will be 30 to 40 minutes in length, with physical distancing, and face coverings required. We will also follow strict cleaning procedures, using a new spray system, new medicalgrade filters, multiple hand sanitizer stations, and more. With all of us working together, we can do this!

At least for the first two weeks, we will ask people to sign up primarily to help us to prepare. There is also a place to volunteer. Many are needed! Please know that this is not a reservation. You may come without signing up. The link to the signup form can be found on the

World Communion Sunday Activities

Join us this Sunday, Oct. 4, as we celebrate World Communion Sunday!

We will conclude our series on Gospel Discipleship in our online worship at 9:30 a.m. with a reflection on Lukans, disciples who are sent to love people as far as the ends of the earth. Then, at 5:30 p.m. we invite people to come to the church parking lot for a shared communion service.

You can park your cars in the lot shared by the Sanctuary and the Great Hall, or line up in your cars around that lot if you want to drive through to receive communion. Pastors Michael and Michelle will broadcast on Facebook Live a short service that will include the communion liturgy and some reflections on the significance of World Communion.

You can either get out of your car and practice masked and safe physical distancing during the service, or you can stay in your car and watch on a wifi capable device as we stream. Once the blessing of the elements has concluded, you can either walk up to the circle in front of the offices -- again maintaining safe social distancing -- or you can receive under the awning through a drive-through option.

We will also have a place to collect canned meat for our Food Pantry, an offering driven by the service-minded hearts of our United Methodist Women. Again, we will nourish others' bodies while our souls are being fed. Join us as you are comfortable and able for this time when we can gather together and praise God as the Body of Christ.

Make a 1610 Investment Story Today!

From Zach Schrick, Director of Youth Ministries:

We know that things look a little bit different this year; we also know that last year's money could not all have been utilized due to the cancellation of trips. We are asking this year if you are already investing monthly with us that you consider continuing that investment. If you are not, then we ask that you consider investing in our C1Youth ministry here at 1610 Prince St. by investing \$16.10 per month for one year beginning Oct. 15 for a total of \$193.20.

We will use all the investments to send each youth to three conference events: Refuge, Veritas, and Assembly. Our own spring retreat, ReConnect, and one summer mission trip for FREE!!

We are praying we reach the 250 investments that it will take to accomplish that goal each year.

It's not just an investment in the youth ministry, it's an investment in the stories created in the space created in our ministry for God to do what God does. This investment is for 8th - 12th graders only.

It's a commitment ABOVE AND BEYOND the pledges made to stewardship and Blessings to Blessings campaigns. The entire investment is **tax-deductible**. You can pay it all in one lump sum of \$193.20 for one, or \$386.40 for two, or \$579.60 for three.

All month-to-month payments

will begin **Oct. 15.** We can easily add to an existing automatic draft if it's set up through the church already. We can set up a new draft – find our draft authorization form on the church website youth page and attach a voided check to it

If you have been investing by direct draft over this last year, then you are all set, unless you would like to make any changes. You can make monthly payments – make the check out to Conway FUMC youth, and in the memo line, write 1610 investment.

We hope that you will consider creating your own 1610 story along with us this year.
