9:30 a.m. - Online

11:15 a.m. - In Person in the Sanctuary

You will not need to make reservations to come, however. We look forward to worshiping with you however you are comfortable (in person or online) as we continue to be the connected Body of Christ.

"Delight" (March 21) - Encounter the beauty and wonder of God's creation as members of our community share footage and reflections from area hiking trails




