UMW Circle Chair Organizes Collection of Books for School in Guatemala

Mariana Linck, chairman of the Pearle McCain Circle of the United Methodist Women at Conway First United Methodist Church, has organized a project to obtain 100 English/Spanish books to be taken to a school in Guatemala.

Mariana became passionate about providing these books after a visit to a school in Guatemala. "In 2015 when I was just 3 months pregnant with Catalina, Edwin and I went on a stove team mission through our Irvine, Calif., Rotary Club in Guatemala, and I'll never forget the kids at the local school who quickly made their way into our hearts," Mariana said.

After moving to Conway,
Mariana came into contact with
FUMC members Bonnie and Steve
Laycock, who have coordinated stovebuilding teams to Guatemala through
this church and others they have
attended.

"I was inspired by Bonnie Laycock's speech on FUMC's Guatemala stove team mission. She explained how much both children and adults loved getting books. Since then it was really in my heart to search for a way to get bilingual and Spanish books for them," Mariana said.

After a year of researching possible donations, the International Book Project, based out of Lexington, Ky., generously donated 100 books for this vision and charged only \$150 in shipping. The shipping was paid for by the Conway FUMC United Methodist Women.

The International Book Project donated the books based on the Circle's request and project description.

The books have been received, and will be ready to send with a mission trip in the fall. They are a combination of hardback and paperback books.

The book project also includes a goal of collecting \$5 per book, which will go toward both Guatemala and local Conway missions for Spanish-speaking children, Mariana said. In addition, \$1.50 will go toward a renewal application to create an on-going mission of securing 100 books for each forthcoming year.
