Holy Week & Easter at FUMC

All are invited to join in the sacred liturgies of Holy Week and Easter. As we enter into the sacred mystery of our salvation, we will be experiencing with the crowds the triumphal entry of our Lord into the Holy City on Palm Sunday, and sitting at the table in the cenacle, on Maundy Thursday.

On Good Friday, we will participate at the institution of the Lord's Supper, see the establishment of the common priesthood and ministry as Jesus washes the feet of his disciples, We will see him pray in the garden, betrayed and arrested, witness him tried and handed over to us from Pilate's pavement, watch as he stumbles and falls along the Sorrowful Way to the Skull Place, be present there with his Mother and the disciple he loved as our Jesus gives up his spirit on the gibbet of the cross, his side pierced with a lance. See him taken down, laid in a borrow tomb.

Then, on Easter Day, we will discover the empty tomb with women of faith, the first to share the news, and see at last our risen Jesus with our own eyes.

The services of Holy Week offer the context for our Easter joy, for through them, we enter most fully into the bitter passion of Jesus, and thus our Easter Alleluias may truly resound in all their glorious splendor.
